



DIVEMASTER PROGRAM

Welcome to Coral Grand Divers, Koh Tao and welcome to your first steps towards life as a PADI professional diver. The Divemaster course involves higher level learning that begins at the Rescue Diver course and expands in the PADI Divemaster course. The PADI Divemaster course expands the problem solving skills developed by the PADI Rescue Diver program, and extends it from accident management and prevention scenarios to supervisory situations with student divers and certified divers.

At the Divemaster level, problem solving emphasizes looking for many possible solutions under the circumstances and choosing the best of several. Divemaster problem solving may include more than safety-related issues, and include handling customer service, business and operational challenges. The course also addresses attitudes and judgment.

Attitudes are emotional influences that shape individual choices ranging from professional behavior, role modeling, personal health and following safe diving practices, to very basic values, such as honesty. Judgment applies attitudes, experience, theoretical knowledge, deduction and intuition to problem solving and making decisions based on variables, sometimes under circumstances that aren't "black or white"

As the entry point to professional levels in diver training, the PADI Divemaster course plays a pivotal role within the PADI System of diver education. Those who join the PADI Divemaster ranks assist instructors with training student divers. They supervise diving activities for certified divers, snorkelers and skin divers. Obviously, as entry-level professionals you can strongly influence the safety and fun divers enjoy during training and diving. At the same time, many PADI Divemasters are looking ahead; gaining professional experience they will apply as PADI Assistant Instructors and Open Water Scuba Instructors.

In the PADI Divemaster course, you're taking the first steps towards a rewarding and fulfilling role in the ever expanding recreational diver industry.





DIVEMASTER PROGRAM

The Divemaster course at Coral Grand takes place over an 8-12 week period and during this time you will find that the more you put into the course the more you will get out. Coral Grand Instructors and Divemasters are here to guide and assist you through the program – but part of being a successful DM candidate comes from independent thinking and learning, problem solving skills and the ability to tackle new challenges so don't expect us to hold your hands! You will be expected to learn and study independently, to work on your diving skills constantly, to be around the dive shop regularly and ensure you learn the logistics of running a busy dive operation.

Our aim is to ensure you leave the program as a Divemaster with the skills and abilities to find work in the dive industry. We want to encourage you to develop the skills employers look for in a Divemaster, the more time and commitment you invest in the Divemaster course, the more successful you will be.

Coral Grand's Divemaster course takes place over an 8-12 week period, because much of this time is taken up by the 'internship' section of the course where you will be, for all intents and purposes, a member of staff; assisting instructors and Divemasters with their daily tasks and learning about the actual operational logistics of being a PADI Divemaster.
