



# Open Water Diver

*The Open Water course (OW) is the first entry-level course to PADI certification; is a 4-day course; consists of five academic sessions, five confined water sessions (swimming pool or bay), and four open water dives to a maximum depth of 18m under the guidance of a certified PADI Instructor. After completion of the OW course, students become internationally recognized certified divers and may then dive without professional supervision. This course begins at 3pm daily (see schedule below) and includes:*

- PADI Recreational Dive Table
- CGD Logbook
- International PADI Certification
