



Rescue Diver

The EFR or an equivalent qualification is a pre-requisite to enter the PADI Rescue Diver course as CPR and oxygen provision is an integral part of the PADI Rescue course.



The PADI Rescue Diver takes AOW divers towards entirely new level of diving where managing and preventing problems to others makes the Rescue Diver a much more aware diver. Probably the most satisfying of all PADI courses, the PADI Rescue course is a 2-3 day course that involves academic and rescue scenarios that raises the diver's level of confidence in their own abilities to assess, and manage emergencies. This course includes:
